DEPARTMENT OF STATE (1789)

Top official: Secretary of State

Carries out foreign policy

Supervises US ambassadors & other diplomats abroad

Represents US in United Nations Issues passports to US citizens

Top official: Sec. of the Treasury DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY (1789)

Collects federal taxes

Controls taxes on alcohol, tobacco, & firearms Supervises printing of money & postage stamps Borrows money & pays bills for federal govt.

DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE (1789)

Top official: Sec. of Defense

Maintains armed forces (Army, Navy, Marines, Air

Conducts military intelligence

Builds & maintains forts, bases, naval yards, canals, and harbors

Carries out military research & engineering projects

DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (1870)

Top official: 'Attorney General

Conducts suits on behalf of federal government in Investigates & prosecutes violations of federal laws

Supervises federal prisons Supervises US attorneys.& marshals

Runs the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI)

DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR (1849)

Supervises federal land & parks Top official: Sec. of the Interior

Finances irrigation projects:

Investigates mine accidents

Protects fish, wildlife, and other natural resources Conducts programs to help Native Americans

> Administers food stamp and school lunch programs Fights animal & plant diseases & insect pests Conducts programs to aid farmers DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (1849) Top official: Sec. of Agriculture

DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE (1903)

Top official: Sec. of Commerce

Promotes business opportunities for US companies here and abroad

Make loans to small businesses

Conducts a population census every 10 years and gathers other statistics

Grants patents for new inventions

Maintains official weights and measures

Operates US Weather Service

Makes surveys of coasts & reports on tides & currents

DEPARTMENT OF LABOR (1913)

Top official; Sec. of Labor

Carries out laws on working conditions, minimum wage, & job discrimination

Administers unemployment insurance and compensation for injured workers

Sponsors job-training programs

Keeps track of prices, unemployment levels, and other labor information

DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING & URBAN DEVELOP. MENT (1965)

Supports private housing mortgage loans Finances housing for the elderly & low income Top official: Sec. of Housing & Urban Development

Makes grants for improvements to streets, sewers, & parks

> Sets safety standards for automobiles, truck, Supports research on mass transit Finances interstate highways & improvements DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (1966) Top official: Sec. of Transportation fuses, planes, & trains to railroads, airports, and some waterways

DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY (1977)

Top official: Sec. of Energy

Promotes research on energy Promotes conservation and development of energy Regulates interstate gas and electricity rates

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (1979)

Conducts programs to aid education Top official: Sec. of Education

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH & HUMAN SERVICES

Directs Social Security, Medicare, Medicaid, and Top official: Sec. of Health & Human Services other social service programs

Enforces pure food, drug, and cosmetics laws Conducts research into causes and treatment of Administers programs to aid the handicapped diseases

Supervises programs to assist military veterans Top official: Sec. of Veterans' Affairs DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS (1989) Operates veterans' hospitals
