

ULBRICHT FOR PRESIDENT?

Do you know how to keep score in a Presidential election? See if you can determine from the chart below who won a totally fictitious election for President of the UNITED STATES OF EUROPE.

The states in Europe decided to form one country and to hold an election for President. They like the electoral college system used by the United States of America to elect its President, so they copy it. The two candidates are Georges Pompidou of France of the Continental Party and Walter Ulbricht of Germany of the Socialist Party. The states in this new country of Europe are listed in the first column, and the number beside the state name is the number of electoral votes the country has. In the next two columns you will find the popular vote each man received in each state. Your assignment is to fill in the electoral votes each man received from each state, and then to fill in the four blanks at the bottom of the page. Remember, the winner will be determined by the electoral vote winner, not the popular vote winner.
